

SmartDocumentor's Privacy Policy

Collection of your personal information

Personal information is data that can be used to identify and/or contact a single person. You may be asked to provide DevScope your personal information when in contact with any of our products or websites. Such information will always be used in compliance with the current Privacy Policy. You are not required to grant DevScope any information we may request, but, if you choose to do so, we may not be able to provide you some products and services.

What personal information do we collect from you and how do we do it?

We collect personal information on our websites and products in order to improve them and provide our users with the best possible experience. This data is collected when the user creates an account on a DevScope website, administers a DevScope license or interacts with any of DevScope's websites. We also use technology like cookies and web beacons to collect data and make sure users have the best possible experience on our websites.

What information does DevScope collect when you use SmartDocumentor?

DevScope doesn't collect any personal information or data when a client uses SmartDocumentor. SmartDocumentor is deployed on-premise, meaning all data is stored client-side. The only information stored by DevScope are blank templates of the documents being processed in order to make the operation more agile and effective.

How do we use your personal information?

The data DevScope collects from you is solely used to operate and improve our business, our products and our services. DevScope does not share any of its users' personal information with any third parties.
